All Rice Import License Holders

INVITATION TO BRIEFING ON

- 1) CHANGES TO RICE PERMIT DECLARATION PROCEDURES AND
- 2) AUTOMATION OF RICE PERMIT PROCESSING

The Rice Control Unit will be conducting two sessions of briefing on the above-mentioned to rice import license holders.

Firstly, there will be changes on the procedures of rice permit declarations in TradeNet for <u>ALL</u> rice importers with effect from <u>7 January 2013</u>.

Secondly, in a move to provide faster turnaround time for rice permit processing, Rice Control Unit will also be rolling out automated permit processing in phases to the importers. In Phase 1, which will commence on 7 Jan 2013, only white rice import licensees and non-stockpile grade licensees will be included. Holders of other types of import licences will be included in later phase(s), whose implementation date(s) shall be announced in due course.
