All Importers of Pet Food Containing Meat & Meat Products

Dear Sir/Madam,

SUBMISSION OF VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE FOR THE IMPORTATION OF PET FOOD CONTAINING MEAT & MEAT PRODUCTS

1. With reference to the circular sent on July 19, 2013, AVA would like to remind that submission of original Veterinary Health Certificate for import of pet food containing meat and meat products is no longer required for the application of Cargo Clearance Permit (CCP).

2. Instead, a **copy** of the Veterinary Health Certificate for pet food is now accepted as supporting document when doing Tradenet declaration. However, the importer must retain in its file the original copy and be made available when AVA requires it for audit and verification.

3. Other supporting documents must be attached in the Tradenet application are still required for submission;

- Bill of Lading/Air Way Bill
