## LIFTING OF RESTRICTION ON IMPORT OF POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS FROM AFFECTED REGION IN HOLSTEBRO MUNICIPALITY, DENMARK

Please refer to our letter dated 9 May 2018.

We are pleased to inform you that the restriction on import of poultry and poultry products from the affected premises in Holstebro municipality, Denmark, is lifted with effect from 11 Aug 2018. Poultry and poultry products from this affected region slaughtered after 11 Aug 2018 will be accepted.

For import from unaffected areas in Denmark, additional certification is required on the veterinary health certificate as listed on Annex 1.

## Annex 1

The additional certification should state on the Veterinary Health Certificate:

- a. Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) and H5 and H7 low pathogenicity avian influenza (LPAI) are notifiable diseases in the country of export.
- b. The birds from which the meat was sourced were not vaccinated against H5 and H7 subtypes of avian influenza (AI), as defined by the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE).
- c. The poultry meat and meat products were not derived from birds originating from the 1 km radius restricted area around the affected premises in Vordingborg municipality.
- d. The poultry from which the meat was derived were born, raised, and slaughtered in Denmark, or were legally imported as day old chicks from countries with equivalent poultry health status.
