## **NEW QUALIFYING BULLION COINS AS INVESTMENT PRECIOUS METALS**

The following bullion coins meet the requirements as an Investment Grade Precious Metals ("IPM") and will be exempted from Goods and Services Tax (GST) with effect from <u>6 Aug 2021</u>:

- a) Canada Creatures of the North series silver coin;
- b) Canada Goose silver coin;
- c) United Kingdom Royal Arms platinum coin; and
- d) South Africa Big Five series platinum coin.
